
## TREE MANAGEMENT NOTES:

Hydrovac new street lighting utilities.

- 2. Lighting pole must be outside of dripline of tree.
- 3. Severance of roots up to 30mm in diameter is supported if roots greater than 30mm in diameter are uncovered while digging the exploratory trench, the contractors must contact Urban Treescapes and provide photos of the roots to enable UTS officers to determine if the root severance will undermine the health
- 4. Contractor vehicles are not to park on the verge or within the TPZ of street trees during construction.
- 5. Materials are not to be stored within TPZ.
- 6. If pruning is required, to existing trees, the applicant will need to provide information about the proposed work for review and approval. Information must include photos indicating where the branches will be cut. Pruning must not be undertaken without written support from Urban Treescapes.



Existing tree on adjoining block to be protected during construction at all times. Provide 1.8m high fence for tree protection. No part of fence will encroach over block boundary or make contact with tree.
