
## NOTES:

- 1. HYDROVAC NEW STREET LIGHTING UTILITIES.
- 2. LIGHTING POLE MUST BE OUTSIDE OF DRIPLINE OF TREE.
- 3. SEVERANCE OF ROOTS UP TO 30mm IN DIAMETER IS SUPPORTED IF ROOTS GREATER THAN 30mm IN DIAMETER ARE UNCOVERED WHILE DIGGING THE EXPLORATORY TRENCH, THE CONTRACTORS MUST CONTACT URBAN TREESCAPES AND PROVIDE PHOTOS OF THE ROOTS TO ENABLE UTS OFFICERS TO DETERMINE IF THE ROOT SEVERANCE WILL
- 4. CONTRACTOR VEHICLES ARE NOT TO PARK ON THE VERGE OR WITHIN THE TPZ OF
- STREET TREES DURING CONSTRUCTION.
- MUST INCLUDE PHOTOS INDICATING WHERE THE BRANCHES WILL BE CUT. PRUNING MUST NOT BE UNDERTAKEN WITHOUT WRITTEN SUPPORT FROM URBAN TREESCAPES.
